0mph

Light air
2mph

Smoke drifts gently.

Light breeze
5mph

Leaves rustle. Wind felt on your face.

Gentle breeze
10mph

Leaves and twigs on trees move. Flags flutter.

Moderate wind

15mph

Small branches move. Paper blows around.

5
Fresh wind
21mph

Small trees start to sway.

6
Strong wind
28mph

Difficult to control umbrella, Large branches
move.

7
Near gale
35mph

Whole trees sway.

8
Gale
43mph

Difficult to walk into wind, twigs broken off trees.

9

Severe gale
50mph

Small branches,
slates and chimney pots blown off.

Storm
59mph

Houses damaged, Trees blown down.

Severe storm
69mph

Serious damage.

12
Hurricane
74mph or faster

Widespread damage.
