

Papier Mache Dinosaur

You will need:

- A balloon
- Scrap paper
- PVA glue
- A pin
- Green paint
- Black paint
- Marker
- Tissue paper
- Camel's hair paint brush (or something to apply the glue)
- Paint brush
- 2 tissue roll tubes
- Sellotape/masking tape

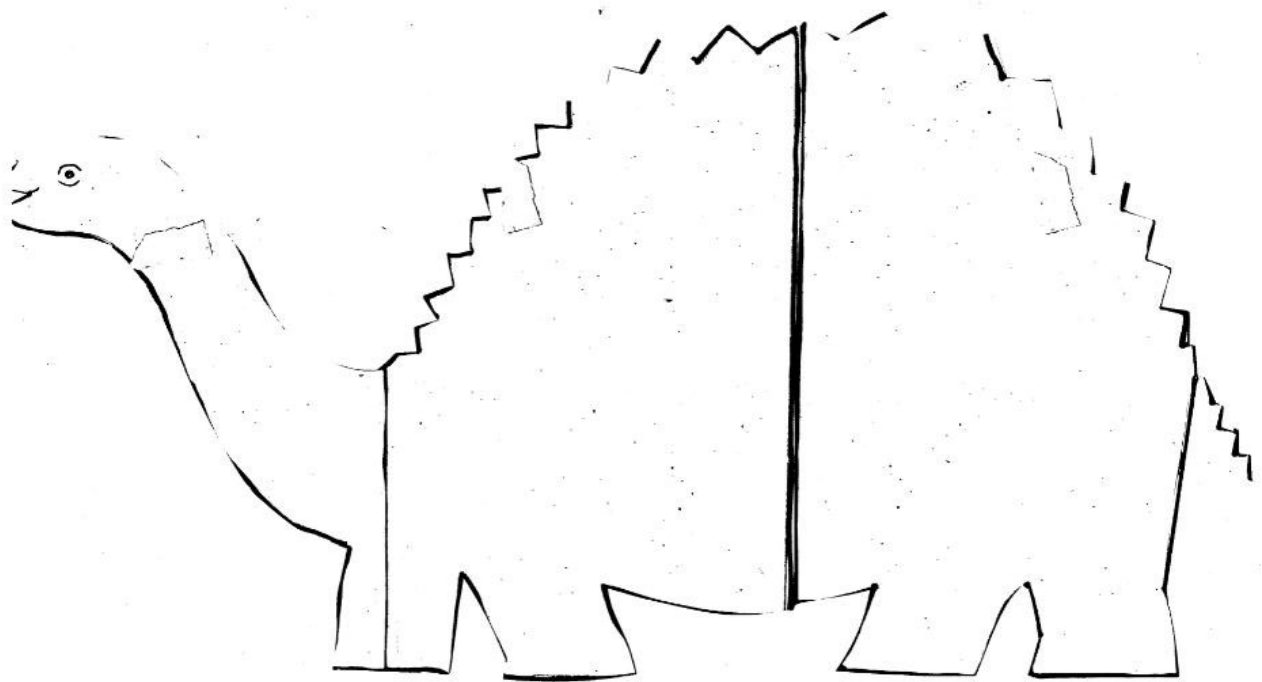


Instructions:

1. Blow up a balloon until it is 7-8" in diameter. Tie up the end.
2. Scrunch up and twist some scrap paper into the shape of a neck and tail. The tail should be thicker than the neck. Tape the neck to the neck of the balloon and the tail to the rear of the balloon.
3. Cut the tissue roll tubes in half and arrange as legs on the underside of the balloon. Tape them in place.
4. Tear up scrap paper into sections and paste with glue. Cover the whole of the balloon and the legs in paper pasted with glue. Put about four to five layers on (more won't harm, but less will), And remember to paste some way up the neck and tail too so that they will stay on.
5. Scrunch up some tissue paper and dip it into the PVA glue. Make two balls this way for eyes And stick them to the end of the neck. Leave all overnight to dry.
6. Peel a slit inside one of the legs and jab the balloon with the pin through the hole. Remove the excess balloon and dispose of it.
7. Paint the dinosaur. You could mix the green with black at the underside of the dinosaur and add more green as you go up to make the top look lighter

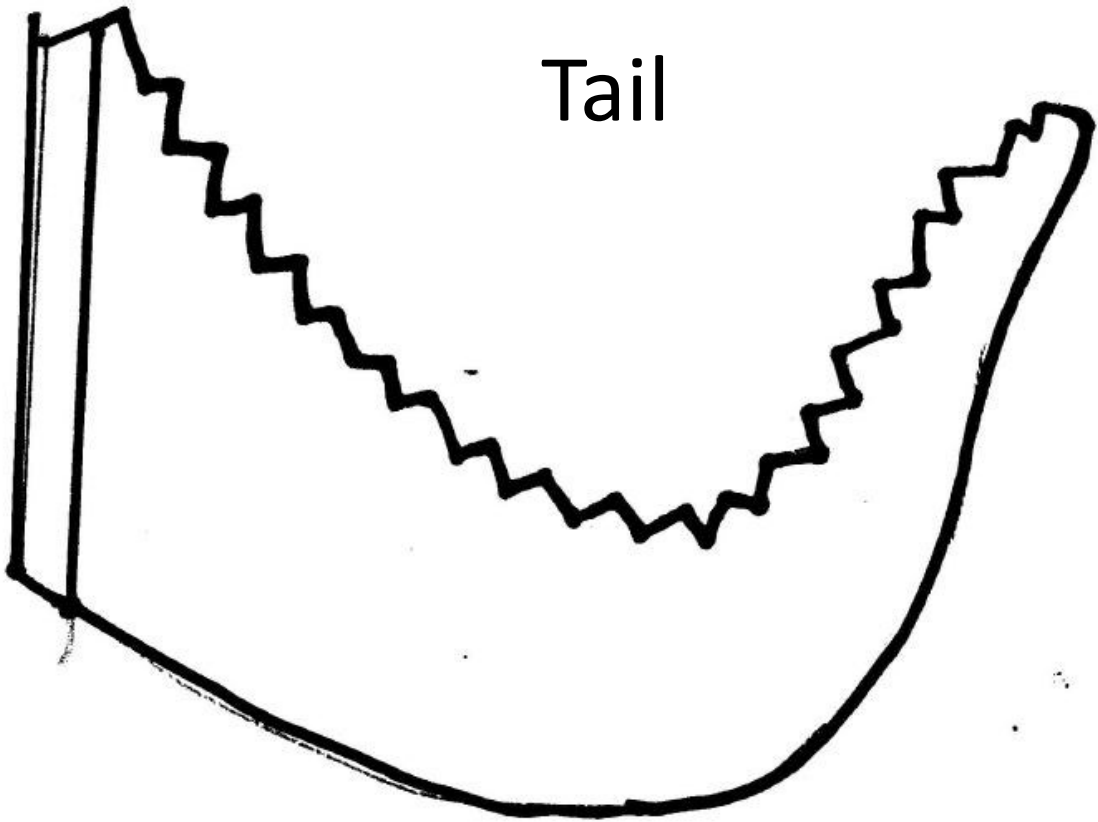
Instructions for making a dino:

Start with the tail (pic 1) and rear of body (pic 2) Stick the tab on the tail to the right hand end of the rear body. Then attach the tab on the rear body in the same way to the front body. Then attach front body tab to the head/neck. Draw an eye.

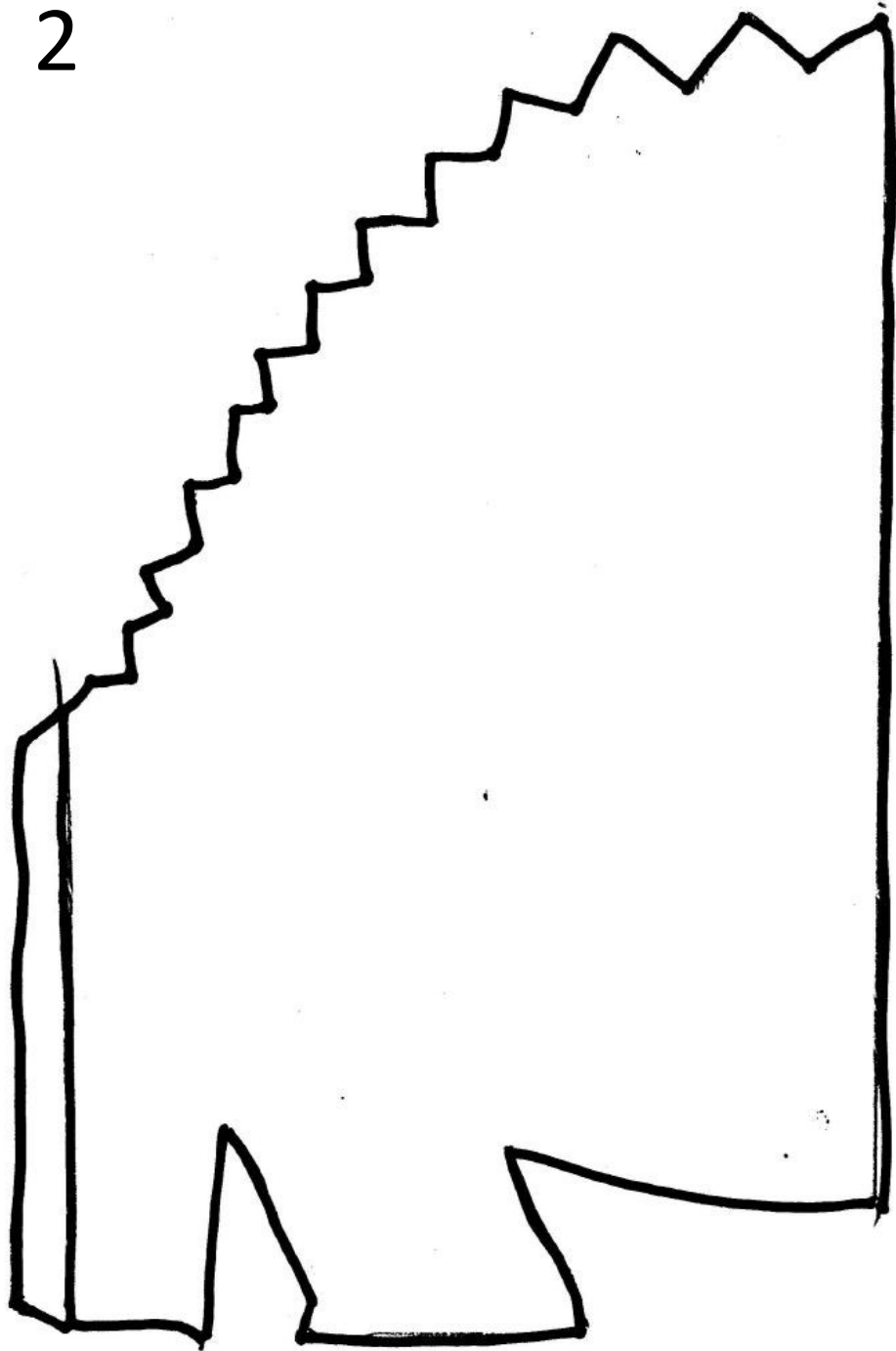


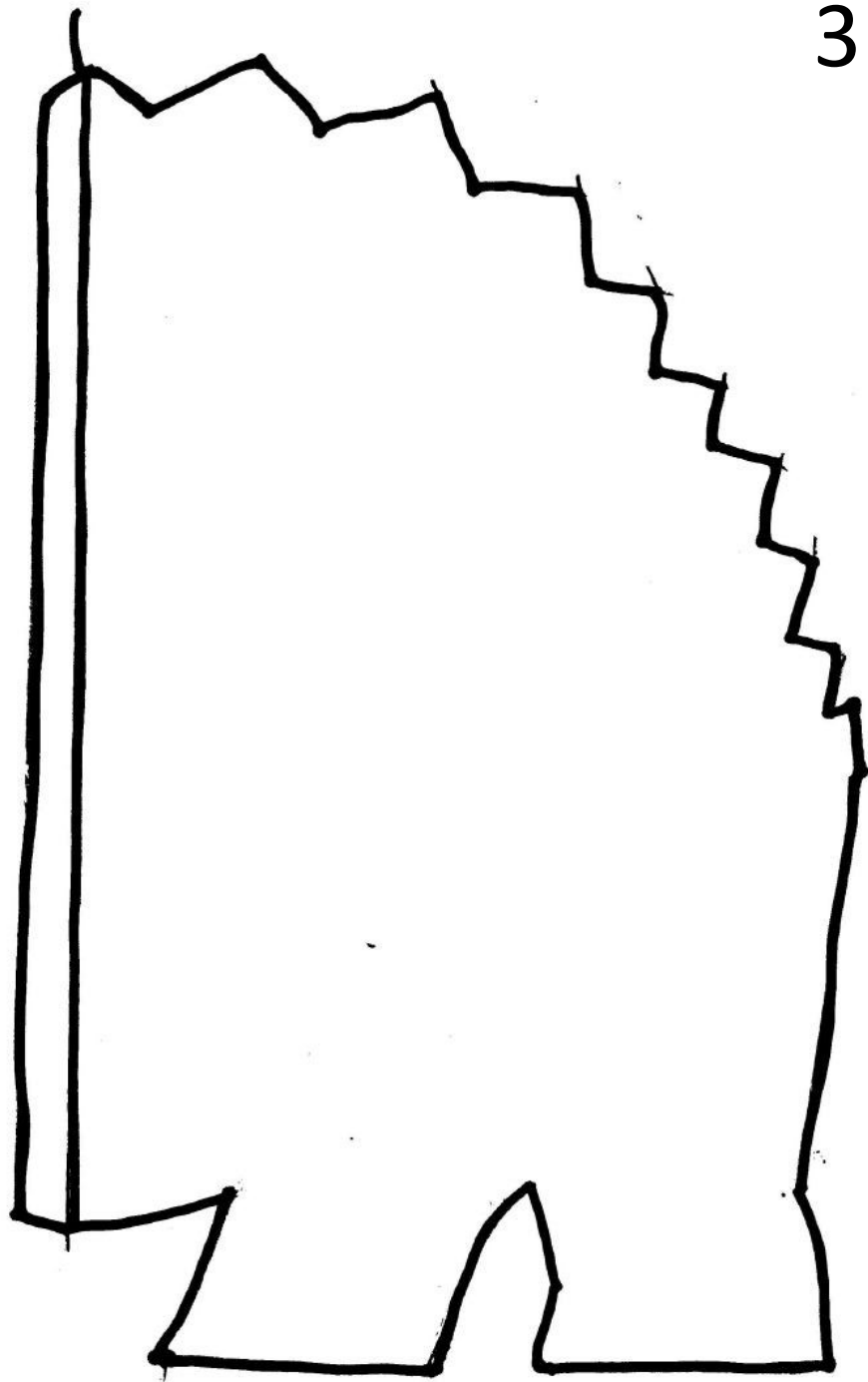

Tail

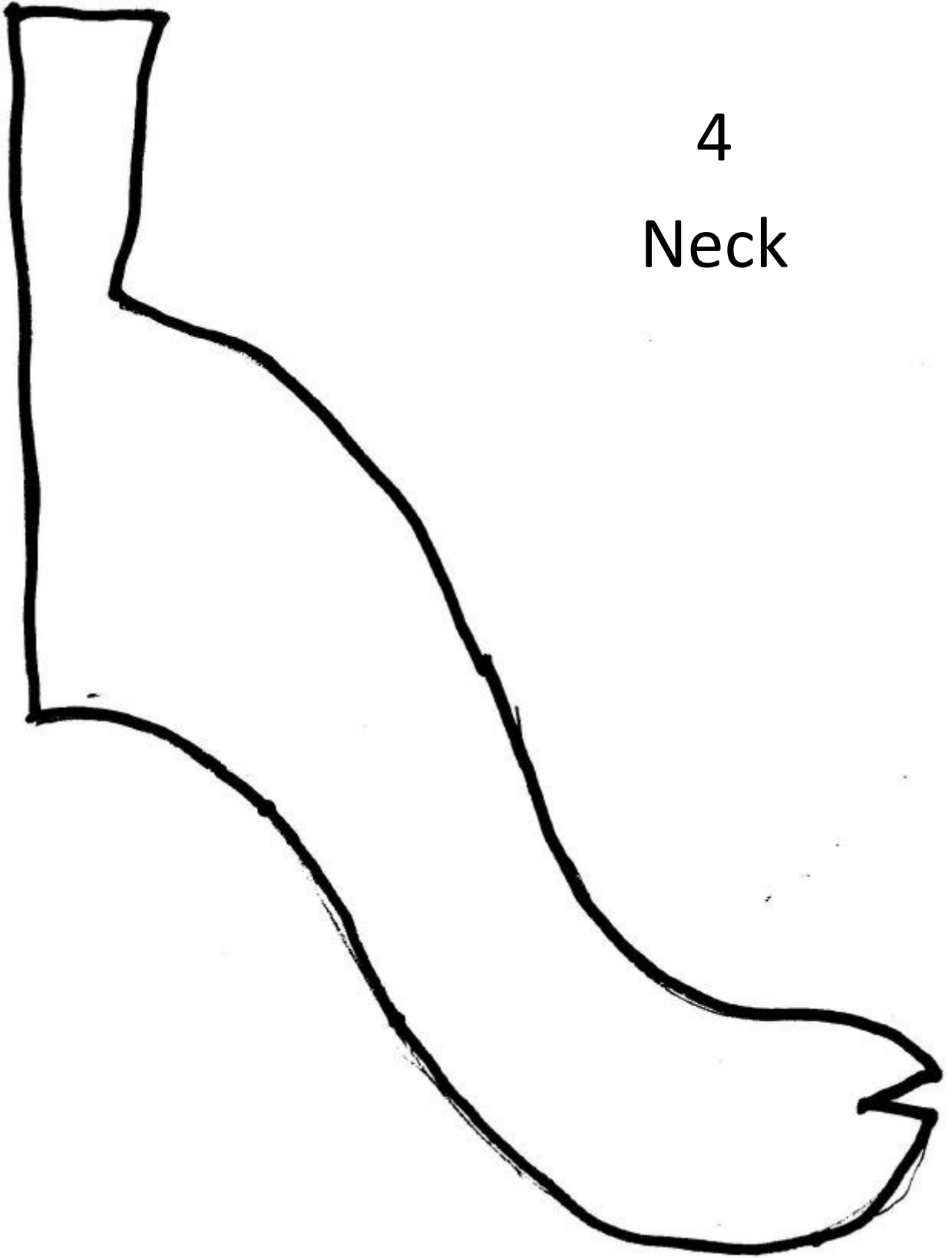
